- ***Write a brief paragraph describing yourself, your family, & your challenges, or write about the successes and/or challenges of supporting your child with intellectual or other developmental disabilities.***
- ***Describe the issue:***
 - ✓ Give specific example(s) of a personal success, challenge, support system, services, etc.
 - ✓ Describe the value (cost savings, quality-of-life improvement, etc.) of the example above. Describe what will happen without the support, law, funding, services, etc.
 - ✓ If your example/issue is related to funding, be sure to list any out-of-pocket expenses that you or your family pays over and above what is typical.
- ***Summarize your story, and “ask” for what you want (support a program, reform a system, maintain funding, support a particular piece of legislation, etc.). If you ask to support a piece of legislation, be sure to include the bill number (for example, HF 1034 or SF 273). Include one of The Arc Minnesota’s legislative key messages:***
 - ✓ *We want a system that empowers people with disabilities and their families.*
 - ✓ *We want a system of supports that meets the needs of people with disabilities and their families.*
 - ✓ *We must change state policies and funding to make our system of disability supports more sustainable over the long-term, including raising revenues fairly.*
- ***Close your story as you would end a letter.***
